Department of Economics

Planning forum in the department provides various opportunities for students personality development.

During this Department year, mobilise 'Economics Exhibition from 26th to 28th of March, 2011. Where 86 charts, tables, maps are on economic related topic and Old coins are Banking tools such as Account displayed. Opening forms, cheques, challans, ATM Cards etc. are also displayed. All students, lecturers, parents, management directors visited the exhibition and express their appreciation.

Department library helps the students to read and refer on various economic issues. Department possess about 200 books and circulating among students.

Department of Political Science:

Seminar is compulsory to all students in the department.

Project works is also made compulsory as a part of assignment.

Department make provision to visit local government offices, to gather practical knowledge and first hand information about the functions of local self government.

Special lecture is arranged for the benefit of students.

Department of English: Apart from regular Tests, Assignments, Seminars, Department arrange spoken english classes and remedical classes for slow learners.

Department of Commerce:

Skill Development activities are made compulsory in the department. Students are asked to collect datas, documents, pictures, for preparation of records. Students visits centres like Banks, factories, income tax offices etc. for gaining practical knowledge. Students of commerce are more frequently uses PPP, in their seminar classes. Computer and Internet Training is given to all students in the department.

Department of Gography:

Geography lab is updated with relevent tools and geo-equipments. Maps, survey kits, topography sheets, weather charts, tracing table etc. are sufficiently available for each student in the department.

Special lectures on GIS: Geographical Information System by Prof. Vishwanath, from Hunsur was arranged. In Practical records, tests, seminars, surveys are also conducted in the department. Departmental tour is arranged to geographically important places.

* Women cell conducted various activities throughout the year. (On 28th of every month). Essay Competition, Debate Competition and Quiz competitions are arranged. Important achiever among women in different fields are introduced to students.

Cultural activities such as dances, plays kits, songs, sarry day, rangoli competitions etc. are arranged on the occasion of women's day celebration. Prizes are also distributed to winners. Talented girls, best volunteer, highest scorer are also felicitated.

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This year State Janapada award winner Smt. Thimmanna aged about 95 year honoured by the Women cell.

Debate Club of the College conducts monthly meetings. More than 80 students registered their name in Debate Club. Current Affairs and burning issues like curruption, earthquake, world cup, inflation, black money, etc. are discussed in the meetings which improves general knowledge as well as social concern.
